

North Pocono Dandy Lion Little League Standing Rules for 2022

Rules are for Baseball and Softball unless specifically noted.

All Divisions

For the 2022 Baseball season, Major, Minor divisions will participate in the Heritage League. Coach Pitch will play in a combined NPDLL/Jefferson Twp League.

1. When playing a team outside the League, at a Dandy Lion Little League field, the home team will be responsible for all duties listed in paragraphs 2(A) through 2(C)(i) listed below.
2. If both teams are from Dandy Lion Little League, the duties shall be divided as follows:
 - A. **Home Team:**
 - i. At a minimum two parents will open and run the concession stand for the duration of the scheduled game.
 - a. The Concession Stand Form must be completed in its entirety and signed by the home manager/coach.
 - ii. Coaches are responsible to secure the complex before leaving, including the field, building, and front gate.
 - iii. The "Hat" shall be passed in all divisions between 2nd and 3rd innings by two (2) uniformed players and an adult volunteer at all Dandy Lion Little League Games played at a Dandy Lion Little League field.

B. Visiting Team:

- i. Before and after the scheduled game the manager and coaches shall ensure the field has been raked and cleaned of all trash and debris.
- ii. Both bathrooms shall be cleaned and restocked as necessary.
- iii. The manager shall appoint an individual (under 13 requires parental supervision) to run the scoreboard/PA System. (Major and Minor only)

C. Each team will be responsible to clean up their side of the field after the scheduled game.

- i. No coach or player from either team is allowed to leave field until trash is picked up and cans are emptied on their respective sides, including the dugout.

3. Managers are to hold regular practices during the entire baseball/softball season.

4. Rainouts:

A. Major, Minor Baseball

- i. All makeup games will be rescheduled through the Heritage League.
- ii. Game must be played on the scheduled make-up date.

B. Coach Pitch

- i. All makeup games will be rescheduled by home team managers.
- ii. Game must be played on the scheduled make-up date.

C. Tee-Ball

- i. All makeup games will be rescheduled by the league after consulting with each team's Manager.
- ii. Game must be played on the scheduled make-up date.

D. Softball:

- i. All games will be rescheduled at the discretion of the Softball commissioner.
 - ii. Game must be played on the scheduled make-up date.
5. During the baseball/softball season, all Managers and assistant coaches will be responsible to assist with field maintenance (i.e. general maintenance, cleanup days, grass cutting, etc.).
6. No player, parent and or coach is allowed to change the issued uniform including the hat and jersey. No alterations shall be made to the issued uniform, including but not limited to, the name on hat/jersey, appointment of captains indicated by a "C" on the hat, emblems, patches or nicknames on the hat/jersey during regular season or All-Star season. Violation of the rule will result in immediate discipline of the player and or coach that may include possible suspension or removal. Parents will also be responsible for the cost for a new uniform.
7. All managers/coaches must be regular members in good standing and approved by the NPDLL Board (see Dandy Lion Little League Constitution).
8. Managers and coaches who fail to comply with the mandatory league requirements shall be brought in front of the Board of Directors for disciplinary action which may include removal from the individual's position.
9. The Safety Officer or a board representative appointed by the Safety Officer shall attend all tryouts and evaluate players.
10. All Managers and Coaches shall inspect each players' bat(s) prior to the first practice of the season to ensure every bat conforms to the 2022 Little League standard. No player is permitted to use a bat for practice or a game which does not conform to the Little League standard.

11. There will be NO refunds once the teams are picked/drafted by the league and managers.
12. Late registrations will not be accepted after tryouts have commenced and teams assigned.

Major League

The Softball and Baseball Major Division will be redrafted for the 2022 Season

1. In the event a Major League team loses a player before the end of the first half, the replacement shall be permanent.
 - A. Any replacement player brought up to Major League after the first half shall enter the Major draft the following season.
 - B. All managers must report to the league commissioner and player agent immediately after a player permanently vacates their roster.
 - i. Failure by the manager to advise the proper parties of a player's continued absence will result in disciplinary action against the manager.
2. If a player is absent for 3 games/practices, the manager shall notify the commissioner and player agent to rectify the situation or find a permanent replacement.
3. Player pitch counts and days of rest will be determined by the Pitching/Catching Rules in the 2022 Official Regulations and Playing Rules for Little League Baseball. (Baseball)
4. League Champion:
 - A. Baseball: The league champion will be decided by an end of the season tournament. Seeding for the tournament will be chosen by a random drawing.

- B. Softball: Set schedule within North Pocono Little League, plus additional game scheduled with Districts. The League will follow district rules during district play and the League rules when playing within our own league. Each League team will play the other League teams at least once before All Star voting (TBD). North Pocono Little League Softball Majors will institute a double elimination playoff, seeding will be determined by random selection.
 - C. There will be a league official at all playoff games.
 - D. Game Timing: Playoff games not finished at 10pm shall be resumed from the point of stoppage at the next available time, to be determined by the Player Agent.
 - E. A regular season game is considered final if 3 ½ innings are complete and if home team is winning.
 - F. No inning shall start after 10pm.
 - G. Umpires: There will be two umpires at the championship game. One umpire will be scheduled for all other playoff games. Umpires shall be Board approved and age 16 or older. (Baseball & Softball).
5. All scorebooks must be completely filled out before the start of each game to include players' full names, number and position being played. Also, the manager or team scorekeeper must have accurate pitch count for every pitcher recorded in their scorebook (Baseball)
 6. Face mask required for all pitchers (Softball only)
 7. All playing rules shall be established by the Heritage League and followed during all games (baseball only). Every Manager and Coach shall read and become familiar with the Heritage League Standing Rules prior to the start of the season.

Minor League

The Softball and Baseball Minor Division will be redrafted each season.

The league champion will be decided by an end of the season tournament. Seeding for the tournament will be chosen by a random drawing. Standings will be kept for the entire season however.

1. Four (4) runs are the maximum to be scored in each half inning.
2. Player pitch counts and days of rest will be determined by Pitching Rules in the 2022 Official Regulations and Playing Rules for Little League Baseball (Baseball)
3. Base Running:
 - A. Softball: No stealing home during the first-half of the season, players can advance one (1) base with a passed ball. Once the second-half of the season has commenced, all stealing is allowed (including home) See district rules.
 - B. Baseball: See Heritage League Rules.
4. End of Season Tournament
 - A. Baseball: Seeding will be based on random drawing.
 - B. Softball: See 4B under Major League.
5. All batters and runners must wear helmets with facemask (Softball) and either a facemask or C-flap (baseball).
6. Pitching:
 - A. Softball (ages 7 – 12) - 12-year-old cannot pitch or catch.
 - B. Softball: 35 feet pitching distance.
 - C. Baseball: 46 feet pitching distance.
7. Umpires:
 - a There will be two umpires at the championship game.
 - b One umpire will be scheduled for all other regular season and playoff games.
 - c Umpires shall be Board approved and must be age 16 or older. (Baseball & Softball).
8. No Infield fly rule (Softball only).
9. Face mask required for all pitchers (Softball only).

10. Standing rules apply to Regular season and tournament play.
11. During play, only a Manager and two assistant coaches may be allowed in the dugout.
12. All playing rules shall be established by the Heritage League and followed during all games (baseball only). Every Manager and Coach shall read and become familiar with the Heritage League Standing Rules prior to the start of the season.

Coach Pitch

1. Each game shall last a minimum of six (6) innings or 1 ½ hours. This rule must be enforced when time allows and there are no additional game to follow.
2. Batting:
 - A. When a batted ball is hit in the air into the outfield or hit on the ground past the outfielder without an error being committed, all runners may advance two (2) bases from their point of origin.
 - B. If the ball was batted off of a tee the runners may only advance one (1) base.
 - C. During the first three weeks of the season, if the batter does not put the ball into play after three (3) swinging strikes, a tee must be used and batter may advance to first base only.
 - D. Starting with week 4, if the batter does not put the ball into play after three (3) swinging strikes, the batter is out (no Tee).
 - E. A manager or coach shall not throw more than ten (10) quality pitches to each batter.
 - F. During each game a continuous batting order shall be used.
3. Fielding:
 - A. There may only be four (4) defensive players in the infield during play.

- B. Defensive players may be assigned to play in the pitcher and catcher positions.
 - i. The player who is assigned to the defensive pitcher position must keep one (1) foot in the dirt on the pitching mound (baseball only).
 - C. There may only be four (4) players in the outfield during play.
 - D. No more than ten (10) defensive players may be on the field during play.
 - E. Outfielders must play, at a minimum, ten (10) feet back from the infield.
4. There is a four (4) runs maximum per half inning.
 5. A championship tournament will not be held in this division.
 6. All players must wear helmets with facemasks (Baseball and Softball).
 7. All players in the field must wear a facemask (Softball only)
 8. Teams will utilize hardballs (not compression) during play.
 9. During play, a maximum of four (4) coaches shall be allowed on the field of play.
 10. Every player will play a minimum of one (1) inning in the infield unless the coach, after consulting the Division Commissioner, deems a player cannot play in the infield because of safety concerns.

Tee Ball

1. All players shall be positioned on the field when a team is in the field.
2. A half inning ends after all batters have batted the ball in play.
3. Each game shall include a four-inning game or 1 ½ hour time limit if there is a scheduled game to follow.
4. During the first half of season, all batters must hit off of the tee.
5. During the second half of the season, at the Manager's discretion, a coach may throw five soft toss pitches to the batter. If the batter does not bat the ball into play after five (5) soft toss pitches, the batter must use a tee.

6. All players must wear helmets with facemasks.

Jr/Sr (Teener)

This Division shall follow the District rules.

All-Star Teams

1. Each All-Star Team shall include, at a minimum, eleven (11) players. The Manager has the discretion to add additional players to the team.
2. The 10-12 team will be selected first, followed by the 8-10 team and finally the 9-11 team.
3. A player must accept his or her first team appointment or he or she will be considered ineligible to play on any other All-Star team. (As per Little League by-laws).
4. Any Major Division Manager or Coach is eligible to manage tournament teams (8-10, 9-11, 10-12) as long as there has not been any disciplinary action against that Manager/Coach.
5. Any Minor Division Manager or Coach is eligible to manage the 8-10 tournament team.
6. Any Manager or Coach interested in managing an All-Star team MUST submit their name in writing to the League Secretary by sending an email to the League email address by **May 16, 2022**
7. The President will nominate a candidate for approval by the Board of Directors. If the President's first nomination is not approved, another applicant will be nominated by the President for approval by the Board of Directors. If there are no names submitted in writing for an All-Star team, that Division will not have an all-star team.
8. Assistant Coaches will be chosen by the All-Star team manager and approved by the Board of Directors only after the All-Star roster has been filled.

All-Star Player Selection:

1. Player Eligibility:
 - A. **Baseball:**
 - i. Only players in the Major and Minor Divisions are eligible for All-Stars.
 - ii. In the event the 8-10 All-Star team cannot complete a full roster from the Major Division, players from the Minor Division will be selected to complete the roster.
 - iii. In the event the 9-11 All-Star team cannot complete a full roster from the Major Division, players from the Minor Division may be selected to complete the roster, if quality of players is acceptable
 - B. **Softball:** Players from Minor and Major Divisions are eligible for All Stars.
2. The All-Star manager and all Major Division team managers will select the entire team roster.
3. If Minor Division players are needed to complete the 8-10 (or 9-11 team) All-Star team, Minor Division managers and the All-Star manager will select the roster utilizing the same format used to select the other All-Star players.
4. All eligible players must sign a commitment letter prior to the All Star selection process.
5. At the time of selection, all selected players shall provide a "Planned Itinerary" if the selected player will not be available for any part of the All-Star season.
6. If attendance requirements cannot be met due to the Planned Itinerary, the selected player will be ineligible for All-Stars and the spot will be filled by the next eligible player as determined by the All-Star Manager.

7. Players must have participated in 75% of the games played by their regular season team at the time of All-Star selection unless the player has a valid extended medical condition/excuse.
8. Excessive absenteeism from All-Star practices and games will not be allowed. A player can miss 1 practice with a valid excuse. If a player misses two (2) practices, the manager must notify the Board of Directors for further review. A player can miss one (1) game with a valid excuse. If a player misses two (2) games, the manager must notify the President. Players can be removed from an All-Star team and permanently replaced if needed by the All-Star manager/Board
9. All-Star selection of players can occur no sooner than Little League Guidelines allows, shortly thereafter practices need to begin, and all practices are mandatory. Failure of All-Star manager and coaches to comply with the attendance rules regarding the All-Star players shall result in disciplinary action by the Board of Directors, including removal from all Managing/Coaching duties.
10. No player outside of NPDLL eligibility is allowed to participate on an NPDLL All-Star team. Eligibility can be attained either by having a home address within the NPDLL boundary, or by the school rule.

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
